Greetings Brothers and Sisters,

Local 401 continues to be fairly busy across our jurisdiction at this time. We are going to see some work complete over the next month and not a staggering amount of calls coming for the first part of summer. There are some calls coming from Darlington in the next month, however I know that not everyone is looking to specifically go there.

Quinte St. Lawrence Building trades met with Worley Friday May 26th and had a very good discussion about how much work the project will have. It seems clear that Union building trades are the first choice for the labour there. Civil contractors have been selected to bid since that meeting and will be tendering the beginning stages soon. I visited the site this week and the answer I got about when we would be there was as early as August and as late as September. The underground work will see a few members starting at that time. I posted a time lapse video of the same plant being built in Europe on our unofficial member Facebook page. It's a much bigger one being built here in Local 401.
