I thank you all for your support in our Election. Congratulations to the other candidates on their new positions and thank you to all of the membership for participating in the process with professional and brotherly/sisterly conduct. It was the highest returned ballot count in Local 401 history for an Officer Election. The Election Committee did an excellent job for this local and its membership. Thank you Martin Raby, Michael Burke, and Kevin Malda. Thank you also to the volunteer's and all the staff at Local 401 who helped with the Election.

I've been in communication with the UA Canadian office and have sent the updated wage schedules which will reflect the Stabilization contribution at \$0.05 per hour for EPSCA and the training fund contribution increase that will pair up with the ICI sector as of May 1st, 2023.

We are much closer to having our new website ready to go live (hopefully within the next couple weeks). The member portal which will be useful to any member accessing it will launch later this year. The staff have done an outstanding job getting information entered and ready for the new systems and new communication abilities that we will be utilising in the not so distant future.

Umicore has started to establish themselves on Taylor Kidd Blvd. leveling a spot for construction trailers as the 2.4 billion dollar project will start this year and continue over the next two years. The battery materials refinery will go ahead and Quinte St. Lawrence Building Trades will be meeting with their representatives this month. I will share more information next month. Several other projects that have been stalled during Covid 19 have started with the process of being retendered. We anxiously await the results of our Contractor success in securing the work.
